COVID-19 Vaccine and Administration POS Billing Guidance

**Updated April 1, 2021 for NEW REIMBURSEMENT
New Hampshire Medicaid Pharmacy Program
(Fee-for-Service and Managed Care)**

New Hampshire Fee-for Service Medicaid remains committed to ensuring New Hampshire Medicaid recipients receive medically necessary care during the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) state of emergency, including preventive services to reduce and slow the spread of the disease.

New Hampshire Fee-for Service Medicaid will be reimbursing Pharmacies at Point of Sale for COVID vaccines according to the dose of vaccine being administered.

The following guidance is being provided to answer questions about how pharmacies should submit claims for payment:

- Prescriber ID field should be populated with the pharmacist's type 1 NPI and the Prescription Origin Code field should be populated with '5 – Pharmacy'.
- NCPDP is recommending that pharmacies submit the claim with Submission Clarification Code (SCC) = 42, which means Prescriber ID Submitted is valid and prescribing requirements have been validated.
- There will not be any ingredient costs associated with these vaccines at this time.
- **Multi-Dose Vaccines:** Pharmacies must submit a SCC = 2 (NCPDP Field # 420-DK) to receive an administration fee of **\$40.00** for the initial dose and a SCC = 6 (NCPDP Field # 420-DK) to be reimbursed an administration fee of **\$40.00** for the final dose of a series for two-dose vaccines.
- **Single-Dose Vaccines:** Pharmacies will be reimbursed an administration fee of **\$40.00** for the single-dose vaccine. No SCC code is necessary for correct adjudication.

The administration fee was effective as of 3/15/2021. If you submitted a claim between 3/15/2021 and 3/31/2021, reverse and resubmit to receive the new rate.
